A SUICIDE PREVENTION PROGRAM

This 26-minute film, developed by the the American Foundation for Suicide Prevention, shows how to recognize depression in you and others and how to encourage each other to seek help.

It's the 2nd leading cause of death for ages 10-24.” -- 2016 Center for Disease Control (CDC)
