

# SPHS Grad Night

## Student Conduct Guide

As a SPHS grad going to Grad Night, you are representing not just yourself, but South Pasadena and South Pasadena High School on Grad Night. You are privileged to enjoy an experience that none of the graduates of South Pasadena High School have experienced in over 50 years. Your behavior on Grad Night can allow Grad Night to be a memorable experience for your class. Unfortunately, poor choices can also jeopardize Grad Night for current and future graduates.

To promote a positive Grad Night experience for SPHS graduates, each of you are expected to respect yourself, your peers, your community and the property and people around you. As a condition of participating in Grad Night, you agree to conduct yourself in a respectful manner at all times during Grad Night.

To participate in SPHS Grad Night, you also agree that you will not possess or be under the influence of any form of alcohol, tobacco, cannabis, E-cigarettes, vaporizers, vape pens, atomizers, electronic nicotine delivery systems, and controlled substances, such as illegal drugs like heroin or cocaine as well as prescription drugs without a proper prescription, during Grad Night.

You also agree that during Grad Night you will not possess any illegal substance (including prescription medication not prescribed to you), weapons (knives, nunchucks, tazers, guns), explosives, firecrackers, butane lighters, anything that emits fire or smoke, paint, permanent markers, and similar items if used to deface property.

And while some of these items may be legal for some graduates to possess in certain circumstances, you agree to refrain from possessing these items as a condition of participating in Grad Night.

If a SPHS graduate is found to possess or be under the influence of any of the above types of items during any portion of Grad Night, or engage in conduct that is disrespectful, the student will be subject to discipline at the discretion of the PTSA Grad Night Chair. The local security authorities and/or police will be contacted. The school will be informed of any misconduct. If the conduct does not result in arrest or detention by the local security authorities and/or police, the PTSA Grad Night Chair will determine the immediate discipline to be applied.

Discipline from the PTSA Grad Night Chair may include but is not limited to being prevented from departing for Grad Night, prevented from entering Disney California Adventure, remaining on the SPHS bus during Grad Night, and being removed from Disney California Adventure prior to the conclusion of the DCA admission period.
